GULGONG or MUDGEES 2-DAY TOUR

Travel north from Broadmeadow through the Hunter Valley. Morning tea and wine tasting will be served as we travel through the coal rich Upper Hunter. On arrival at Muswellbrook we take a short break before joining the famous Sandy Hollow to Maryvale railway for the cross-country journey through Denman and Sandy Hollow. We travel along the scenic Goulburn River Valley for many kilometres before passing through the Great Dividing Range. Arrival at Gulgong Station is around lunchtime where you will be transferred by coach to the historic township of Gulgong with its many preserved buildings from the Gold Rush days. Take lunch at your leisure as you take in the sights or visit the award winning Pioneer Museum or the Henry Lawson Centre.

Your accommodation is the Ten Dollar Town Motel, where your evening meal will be served in the motel's dining room – Phoebe's Restaurant. Optionally, you can move to the historic Prince of Wales Opera House after dinner for an Australiana Show given by the local musical society.

Breakfast is served in Phoebe's Restaurant after which we join the waiting coach for a tour of the Honey Haven and a selection of Mudgee Wineries. After wine tasting, a barbeque lunch will be served at one of the wineries before returning to Gulgong to join the train for the return journey to Broadmeadow.

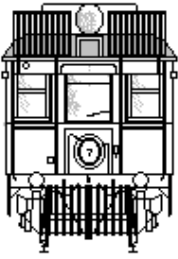
