NORTH WEST COUNTRY PUBS 2-DAY TOUR

Travel north from Broadmeadow through the Hunter Valley. Morning tea and wine tasting will be served as we travel through the coal rich Upper Hunter. On arrival at Muswellbrook we take a short break before starting to climb the Liverpool Range and passing through Ardglen Tunnel to the railway town of Werris Creek. After a short break we set out across the cross-country line to the small township of Spring Ridge. You join a waiting coach to transfer you to the local Royal Hotel for a barbeque lunch in the pub grounds. After lunch the coach takes a cross-country route through the North West Cotton Belt, stopping at some country pubs on the way for a cleansing ale before arriving at Gunnedah.

Your accommodation is the Billabong Motel, while your evening meal will be served in the adjoining Services Club.

After breakfast is served at the motel, we join the waiting coach for a tour Gunnedah and surrounds before joining the train at Gunnedah Station. We travel on to Curlewis for morning tea at the Commercial Hotel after which we travel on to Werris Creek and to Quirindi. Lunch is served at the local RSL Club after which we join the train for the return journey to Broadmeadow.

This tour is ideal for groups or social clubs.

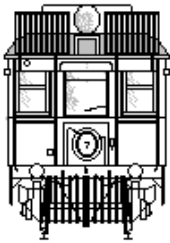
